Grace Home receives donation for computers

A \$1,500 donation by FNBT in March will be used to replace three computers used by residents at Grace Home to complete their online school lessons and tests. This allows women to complete their education, to better provide for their families, all while being in a facility which provides support and care for their young children.

Grace Home Inc. will also replace three laptops used by staff to aid in the continuation of the organization's mission.

Having young mothers receive an education is a key element to Grace Home Inc. says, Executive Director Jeff Cockroft.

Grace Home Inc. serves women age 18-30 who find themselves in an unplanned pregnancy. Grace Home houses six residents at a time and each mother is permitted to live in the facility up to one year after giving birth.
