Community gathers to feed those in need

Friend Public School has partnered with First National Bank & Trust Co. bankers to feed families in need for the Thanksgiving holidays by starting a Thanksgiving basket food drive.

On Oct. 12, Assistant Manager Vanessa Morgan visited with students to educate them about the food drive. In this program, the classroom who donates the most canned food items will receive an ice cream sundae party provided by FNBT.

“Statistics show one in four Oklahoma children are at risk of going to bed hungry,” Morgan said.

“Thanksgiving is a special time where no one should have to go without a meal. This is why FNBT and Friend Public Schools are teaming together to feed families in the community.”

The Thanksgiving basket food drive will be collecting items through Nov. 15. Items needed for the baskets are: boxed potatoes, stuffing mix, gravy mix, canned sweet potatoes, marshmallows, canned corn and canned green beans.

“We encourage others to donate,” Morgan said. “Spencer’s Supermarket has already donated turkeys!”

Donation boxes for the food drive will be located at Friend Public School and the FNBT Drive-in on 122 North 6th Street in Chickasha.

“Once all the food baskets are gathered, we will deliver the food to the Salvation Army for the volunteers to disperse to the families in need,” Morgan said.
