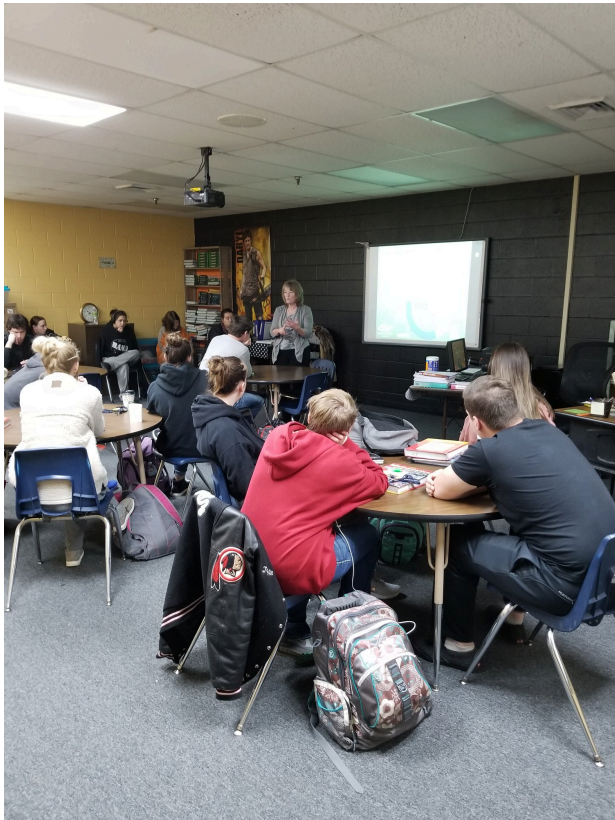
Rush Springs students learn about credit card dangers, savings benefits

Students in Margie Ogle's class have been studying financial skills and on Feb. 20 First National Bank Manager Kasey Englebretson and Trainer Jo Perryman were invited to share a program about dangers and benefits of credit cards and savings accounts.
