## **Blanchard senior citizens get help following Equifax breach**

First National Bank Senior Vice President Ann Manchester spoke with Blanchard senior citizens this month about data breaches and identity theft.

Following the recent Equifax breach, many seniors were concerned about identity theft, but unsure on how to go about securing themselves. Manchester set up a presentation of step-by-step instructions on how to navigate the Equifax website so they can check if they are at risk and sign up for free monitoring of their credit reports.
