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Lions learn bank preparations when traveling

“How do you prepare for a trip out of town?” This is the first question First National Bank employee Ja’nette Lokey asked the Chickasha Lions Club members during their meeting on Sept. 18.

The Chickasha Lions Club hosted FNBT Assistant Core Operations Manager Ja’nette Lokey’s to present the importance of how to protect one’s money while on vacation.

She explained how vital it was to contact the bank before leaving the state or country in order to protect the use of their debit card and money in case of fraud.

In most cases, if a charge from another state or country occurs on the account, the bank freezes the access to prevent a fraudster from stealing from the customer. If the account owner notifies the bank of travel plans, this would have been explained and the interruption in service would be prevented

“In my presentation, I provided the members with contact information to assist them in case fraud did occur on their account for future trips. I also explained FNBT’s new secure app called Securlock,” Lokey said. “With this new app the user has access to turn off their debit card automatically when they are not using it or if they misplaced the debit card.”
